### 1.1. ImmunoHUB page (version 1.0)

ImmunoHUB website **version 1.0** was launched in December 2020 for the preannouncement of the job/position opportunity. It was later updated (January 2021, **version 1.1**) with more details of the application procedures and other details. The preliminary version will later on give rise to a more complex website, once the Era Chair team start to work inhouse, to incorporate the Era Chair holder's vision of the project.
